

## Training Tips & Tricks

### Exporting Data from VL Analyzer 3.0 to the NAIC Stock Selection Guide

This is a new feature in the Value Line Investment Analyzer. Basic data sufficient to complete a Stock Selection Guide (SSG) using either Investor's Toolkit or NAIC Stock Analysis. It is expected that Value Line will shortly expand the data available to include additional past years of quarterly sales and earnings data as well as back fill the monthly price history.

The following instructions were provided by Value Line.

#### I. Create NAIC Files

1. Open The Value Line Analyzer 3.0 software.
2. Connect or work off-line.
3. Close "tip of the day" when applicable.
4. Click Summary & Index.
5. Click the "display" button.
6. Highlight companies to export. Click and hold down "Ctrl" key to highlight multiple companies. If you wish to export the entire list, skip this step and proceed to next step.
7. Choose **File | Export | NAIC Stock Selection Guide (.SSG)**
8. Window will indicate a successful export. Close window.
9. Files will be exported to "**C:\programs files\Value Line Publishing\Value Line Investment Survey\\*NAIC**" directory.\(ticker).ssg.

#### II. Open NAIC Software

Investor Toolkit

1. Click Study Stock Icon.
2. Choose "Import a data file located on a floppy disc or in a folder on my computer."

Stock Analyst

3. Click on Open Company (file folder)
4. Select "SSG Data Files"

*\*Assuming default installation folder*

Requirements: *NAIC Stock Selection Guide (SSG)* software and *Value Line Analyzer 3.0* July 2004 edition or later.
