## Recording Webinars

Guidelines for session presenter(s):

- Set monitor resolution to 1024 x 768

### Method Comparison:

	Advantage	Disadvantage
<b>Camtasia</b>	Ease of editing Small file size (MP4) Good for CD or DVD	Dedicated computer for recording Complicated recording setup Cost of program
<b>Citrix</b>	Quick and easy to record Minimum training required	Not editable Large files Limited storage with Citrix

### Comments:

ScreenCast recommended for storage. Free to low cost for chapters. ScreenCast and Camtasia are products of TechSmith ([TechSmith.com](http://TechSmith.com)).

Camtasia recording requires the ability to feed the audio from the speaker back into the microphone input. Methods are:

- Audio card with ability to record system audio
- Looping a Patch Cable - Direct feedback of speaker output into microphone input via a short audio cable
- Phone patch
